<p>APPLICATION PROCEDURE</p> <p>DEADLINE TO RECEIVE APPLICATIONS</p> <p>REQUIRED APPLICATION MATERIALS</p>	<p>You must be officially nominated by the International Office at you home institution! Nominations must be done at least 14 days before the deadline.</p> <p>June 15 th for the fall/winter semester November 15th for the spring/summer semester</p> <p>For creating the application AND Learning Agreement we recommend using EASY dreamapply: https://aec.dreamapply.com/ (*)</p> <p>Due to the need to prevent TWO different Learning Agreements, please make sure to notice us beforehand if you use OLA!</p> <p>Your application should contain:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) motivation letter and CV (voluntary application form) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • name and last name of the student • date of birth, place of birth • year of study • name of sending school and erasmus code: D NURNBERO1 • information about winter or summer semester 2) portfolio (preferably pdf) 3) document proving the knowledge of English language (level B1 or higher, and other foreign languages as German) 4) learning agreement (*)

<p>ACADEMIC INFORMATION</p> <p>TERM DATES AND ACADEMIC CALENDER COURSE CATALOGUE https://www.adbk-nuernberg.de/studium/vorlesungsverzeichnis/</p> <p>LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION</p>	<p>Level of Study: Undergraduate, at least in the 3rd term</p> <p>Exchange numbers: according to our bilateral agreement 2 student = 1 semester</p> <p>winter semester: October 1st - March 31th (4 months of teaching)</p> <p>summer semester: April 1st - September 30th (4 months of teaching)</p> <p><i>You can find the current lecture time in the course catalogue.</i></p> <p>Exchange students can choose their courses and workshops from the current course catalogue. Important are the class meetings which normally are once in a week.</p> <p>Presentations and exams appointments are to fix out with the respective professor.</p> <p>There is a possibility to participate in the final exhibition at the end of the summer semester.</p> <p>The primary language is German. For the class meetings it is essential to know the basics of German conversation (A1, A2). The language requirement is good English.</p>
<p>INSURANCE</p>	<p>All students are obliged to have a sufficient (standard health and accident insurance) health insurance valid in Germany during their stay as exchange students. It can be purchased in your country of</p>
